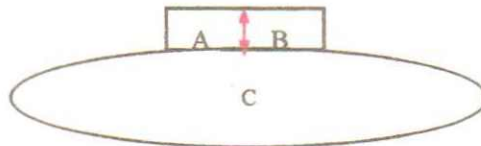


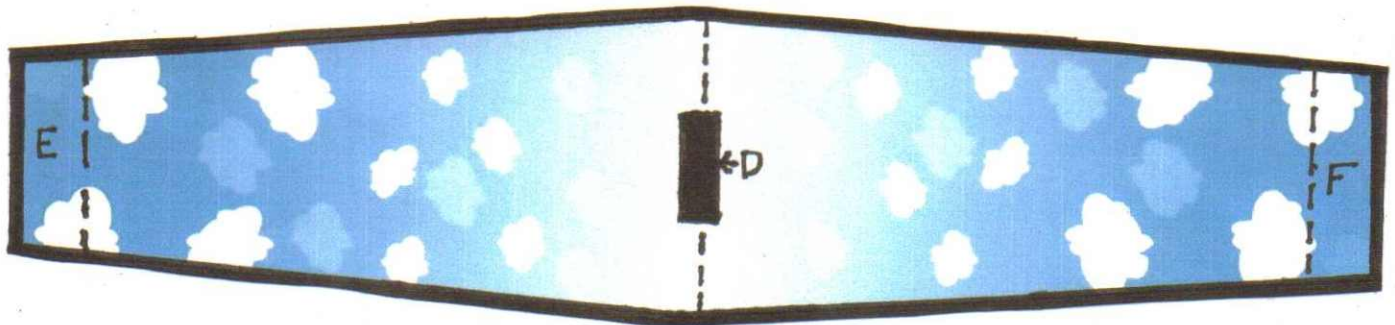
To make your very own Flapping Cecropia moth.
All that you need is; an 8 1/2" by 11" sheet of card stock, scissors,
a craft stick, and some tape or glue.



CUT THE BUTTERFLY OUT AND THEN FOLD IN HALF TO FORM A CREASE
ALONG THE CENTER LINE. THEN FLATTEN IT BACK OUT



CUT OUT BODY PART C, INCLUDING A & B. NEXT CUT A CENTER LINE BETWEEN A & B TO
CREATE TWO FLAPS AND FOLD IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS. TAPE OR GLUE FLAPS A & B TO
UNDERSIDE OF THE BODY ALONG THE CENTER CREASE



FOLD ALONG THE BLACK DOTTED LINES. CUT OUT BLACK RECTANGLE D
PLACE STICK THROUGH HOLE AND TAPE OR THE TIP TO BODY AT 'C'. THEN TAPE
OR GLUE END FLAPS E & F TO THE UNDERSIDE OF WINGS 1" IN FROM EACH WING
EDGE. TO MAKE WINGS FLAP USE UP AND DOWN MOTION OF THE CRAFT STICK.
